

General Terms – St Hil'air Club Consignment Stand Coupe Icare 2026

Opening Hours :

- The Second-Hand Market stand is run by the St Hil'Air club. It's open Thursday 2pm–7:30pm, Friday 10am–7:30pm, Saturday 10am–7:30pm, and Sunday 10am–3:30pm.
- Unsold gear or sale proceeds must be picked up by the seller no later than Sunday at 3:30pm. Anything not picked up will be donated to the "Ailes pour Eux" association.

What the St Hil'Air Club takes care of:

- Receiving gear during opening hours
- Posting the sale listing at the price set by the seller as quickly as possible
- Accompanying buyers if gear is shown outside the stand
- Not handling out gear for flight testing
- Collecting payment from buyers
- Paying sellers the sale amount, under the general sales terms below
- Not sharing a seller's contact details until the sale goes through
- Not keeping any personal info

The St Hil'Air Club takes no responsibility for:

- The origin, condition, quality, or warranty of the gear on consignment (wing, reserve parachute, harness, flight instruments, etc.)
- Listings going missing from the boards at Coupe Icare
- The buyer's identity
- Info provided by the seller about their gear
- The price set by the seller
- Any accident or damage happening while gear is being tried out

General Terms for consignment & sale:

- The consignment fee depends on the sale price:
 - €5 if the item is listed under €300
 - €10 if the item is listed at €300 or more
- Minimum listing price is €50 (**even if the seller changes the price later**)
- Sale price: no cents, and it **must be a multiple of €10**
- If sold, the St Hil'Air club keeps 10% of the sale amount
- Buyers pay in Euros only. Card payment is possible (subject to technical availability). If paying by cheque, only French one are accepted, ID is required.
- Sellers get a voucher when they drop off their gear. This voucher must be shown to collect unsold gear or the sale proceeds (except for items handled by WINGSHOP. Gear pickup requires ID plus the voucher or a photo of it)
- Wings can be laid out near the stand. A Club St Hil'Air member accompanies the buyer during the viewing. Reserve parachutes can't be unpacked/deployed
- The price is whatever the seller sets — the club doesn't handle any negotiating
- Gear is sold as-is; it's up to the buyer to check it over. The purchase is entirely the buyer's call and means they accept the gear's condition
- **Once sold, gear can't be returned and money can't be refunded to the buyer**
- Sellers get paid by cheque, guaranteed by the St Hil'Air club, for any amount over €1000 (any E.U. country). For sellers outside the E.U., payment is by wire transfer.
